Billy Mock was a loving Christian with a dynamic enthusiasm for life. His infectiously positive attitude, ever-present smile and vibrant personality literally impacted the lives of thousands of people. Billy began fighting brain cancer in 2005 and touched thousands of lives until his death in 2007 at the age of 13.



The Billy Mock Foundation is a tribute to Billy and his compassion for people, love for life, and passion for sports.

Our mission is simply to "help others" which is achieved through Pay it forward program which is to encourage people to help others; educational grants; and support of families in need especially those with a sick child.

The Billy Mock Foundation (a 501 (c) (3) non-profit organization) was established in 2008, on what would have been Billy's 14th birthday, by the Mock Family and friends. It has awarded numerous scholarships, provided financial support to many families in the region, and supported many local groups working within our community to improve the lives of others.

The Billy Mock Foundation hosts two main fundraisers: an annual 5K Run/1 mile walk, scheduled for April 22, 2017 at Ridley Creek State Park and annual a golf outing in October.

Families in Need Program

- Assisted 8 individuals and their families experiencing personal and financial hardship. Some of the ways we helped:
- Financial assistance for household expenses
- Financial help with personal and healthcare related costs
- Contributions to personal fundraising events for those facing extensive healthcare costs
- The Foundation teamed up with Goodwill of Delaware and Delaware County and provided holiday turkeys and Acme gift cards to 10 members of their Workforce Center at Thanksgiving as well as purchasing Christmas gifts for the less fortunate.

Educational Grants Program

A total of 12 Educational grants were awarded this year.

- For the 2016/2017 fiscal year, The Billy Mock Foundation awarded 12 educational grants. Four (4) needs-based grants and seven (7) "Simply Helping Others" grants were awarded to students from the following schools: Holy Family Regional School in Aston, St. Cornelius School in Chadds Ford, St. Joseph's School in Downingtown, and St. Thomas the Apostle School in Glen Mills.
- One Institutional Grant was awarded to Drexel-Neumann Academy in Chester. The BMF has supported the Drexel -Neumann Academy for many years

Assisted the community through the following projects:


- Provided butterflies for the funeral Brielle Avery Barber a St. Thomas the Apostle's preschool student who tragically lost her battle to cancer.
